Laboratory Safety Orientation Checklist

<u>Laboratory Safety Training Review by Lab Training Manager (PI or Designee)</u>

NOTE: The PI may authorize another person to operationally fulfill the role, but it remains the Principal Investigator's responsibility to ensure that all personnel in the lab have the necessary skills (through training and experience), maturity and supervision to work safely in a lab with hazardous processes or substances. Consider the varying maturity and experience levels when orientating a person to the lab and when determining the appropriate assignments and supervision and training required.
